

VIDEO SURVEILLANCE SYSTEMS

Privacy Information ex art. 13 Legislative Decree 196/2003

Pursuant to the Legislative Decree Law No. 196, dated 30th June 2003, relative to the protection of people and other individuals, with reference to personal data processing, we wish to inform you that the company, Lepanto Yachting Service s.r.l. has installed a video surveillance system with fixed video cameras, speed domes (the tracking and P&T has been turned off) and image recording.

The video cameras focus, in particular, on the following areas:

- Entrances;
- Company car parks;
- Jetties.

There are signs that can be seen, even during the dark, in proximity with the areas under video surveillance.

a) The purposes which data processing is aimed at.

Personal data is processed by the Data Processor and Controller in order to oversee the aforementioned areas in such a way as to avoid any unlawful acts being perpetrated against the company, its employees and clients, who enter the Marina Lepanto area, as well as to protect its clients' boats, within the limits established by the law and regulations in force, with particular reference being made to **"Measures on the Subject of Video Surveillance"** established by the Ombudsman in relation to personal data protection.

b) Data processing methods.

With reference to the aforementioned purposes, personal data processing take place by using electronic, manual and automated resources, whose logic is strictly connected with the same purposes and, in any case, in such a way as to guarantee the information's security and confidentiality. Conservation of the recorded items will take place in compliance with the provisions of the law.

c) Data communication and diffusion.

Access to the data will be exclusively set aside for the appointed personnel; therefore, no communication or diffusion of information has been envisaged, except in the case of a crime having being ascertained or presumed. In this case, the information may be divulged to the legal authorities and the Police for the activities envisaged by law.

d) Rights to which the interested parties are entitled, pursuant to Article 7 of the Legislative Decree 30 June 2003, n. 196.

Article 7 of the Legislative Decree No. 196, dated 30th June 2003, grants the interested parties the right to sustain specific rights, inherent in the protection of their privacy. Or more precisely, the interested party is entitled to receive confirmation from the Data Processor and Controller as to the existence or not of his personal data and that said information should be given to him, drawn up comprehensibly. The interested party may also ask for the source of his data, as well as the logic and purpose of its being processed; or even object, for lawful reasons, to its being processed.

e) Data controller.

The data controller is Lepanto Yachting Service s.r.l., a one member company based in Via Consiglio d'Europa n. 38 - 34074 Monfalcone (GO).

f) Data processor.

The data processor is Mrs. Silvia Pozzerle.
